SECLUDED BEACH

A major attraction is the **sunset photography** - the African **sunset** dances in front of our **beach camp fires**, making an unforgettable, breathtaking tropical paradise.....

NATURE WALKS & Jogging Trail

A **Bio-diversity** of vegetation from the **coastal thickets**, to a mountainous range, offering **3 types** of mangrove forest, Acacia Savanna, bush & thorn veldt, indigenous medicinal plants, fruits and trees, dominated by giant baobab trees with Grassland mosaic in a valley. It's a **Bird watchers** paradise in a well-balanced eco system – look out for the elusive Bat Hawk and Pale Batis. The mangroves occupy 12 different species of crabs as well as a plethora of insects which attract small mammals, reptiles and birds. The ancient Nacole Baobab is a must see, one can walk **inside** the hollow tree and learn about the war refugees who once took shelter within its trunk.

The **MUD BATH** is a favorite for releasing the **child within**. Its warm soft mixture of black mud, **rich in minerals**, extracts all the stress and toxins from your body. It softens your skin, improves your complexion and conditions your hair. There is a powerful **tonic** in the mud getting all to play and giggle, allowing you to relax the dirty way. An extremely spiritual experience.

SCUBA DIVING and FISHING

An underwater photographer's paradise at 3m–5m deep, with the most extensive varieties of coral. Deeper is the largest **Giant Fan** coral in Africa. Passionate conservation work with Maritime and Police is sponsored and motivated. Kayaking or motorized raft through the mangrove estuaries offers a unique opportunity for fishing. Dolphin Safaris are also available.
